

Class 2 Curriculum Overview

Summer 2

Topic: France



English - In English, the children will be learning about and writing information texts. We will then be able to apply this knowledge across the curriculum. We have grammatical and spelling objectives to cover this half term, mainly apostrophes and homophones.

Maths – We will be linking our maths topic of shape and measures across the curriculum. During sports week, we will look at using time and measuring time as well as measuring other using other units

Science – Investigations

Our focus this half term will be investigations. Class 2 will be using their mathematical knowledge of measures and their understanding of information and explanation text to write up their fair tests.

Topic – In our topic work we shall be locating countries within Europe. Further to this we will be comparing the human and physical features of an area in France. Mrs Gale, originally from France, will be helping us with some 'local' knowledge.

Computing – Our computing this half term will focus on e-safety. We will be implementing our growing knowledge of safe use of the internet to research our topic.

Art and Design – This term we will be looking at French food. Through this context, the children will try different foods, design, make and evaluate new foods by creating, adapting and refining recipes

P.E. – In P.E. we will learning tri-golf. We are lucky to be having Mr Alistair Grindlay, an advanced PGA professional teach some of the tri-golf sessions. Mr Warriner will be teaching athletics
