

## Class 3 Information – Summer 2 2018

### Our learning

**Maths** – This half term, Year 5 and 6 will focus on fractions, decimals and percentages as well as consolidation of the 4 operations. Through each unit, the children will investigate using manipulatives; see variations of pictorial representations and practice fluency, reasoning and problem solving using abstract forms. Year 5 will be undertaking end of year assessments in week 3 of the half term; as such we will be revising some of the topics already covered this year

**English** – In English we will be using the text *Peter Pan* by J. M. Barrie. Here we will be looking at varying the type of sentences used, and punctuating these correctly. For instance looking at the different ways we can use a colon. Later in the half term, we will turn our focus to the world cup and Russia 2018. We shall look at football commentary, before trying to write our own commentary based on some of the exciting matches.

### Our topic this half term is 'Islands'

**Geography** – Researching and comparing human and physical differences between parts of an island and different parts of the world. Through this we will also look at 6 figure grid references.



**Art/DT** – Class 3 will be designing and making Japanese kites. Later in the half term, the children will be making sushi.

**RE** – Christian Aid & Islamic Relief, can they change the world?

**Science** – Animals including humans. Through this unit, the children will also have classes in sex and relationship education. This will focus on changes to our bodies, how babies are born and for the year 6s, who babies are made.

**Music** – Preparing for the End of Year production.

**Computing** – Programming and Technology in our Lives - creating games

**P.E.** – Mr Warriner will be teaching Volleyball. In our Friday session, this half term we will be leaning about athletics ready for the cluster sports competitions and our sports day. Please have kit in on a Monday and take it home on a Friday. Although it is summer, you may still want a jumper to keep warm.

Y6 will also be completing their Youth Trust Awards this half term.
