Class 1

This week we have been learning more about Autumn. We went on an Autumn walk around the school looking at all the things that we can see at this time of year. We have been learning an Autumn poem and working on our addition and subtraction skills. The children enjoyed performing their poem to Class 2 and the rest of the school on Friday.

Class 2

Class 2 came bounding back on Monday and we have got straight into our new topics. This half term we are studying Australia (details were on the class information letter which can also be found on the website in the curriculum section). The children have already begun sharing objects from home on the topic table - please feel free to allow children to bring in items that link with the subject. We also got started with our Science topic-Forces and Magnets with Y2 conducting a 'Which ball is the bounciest?' investigation and Y3/4 investigating materials and forces with car movement on different surfaces. In our growth mindset sessions this half term we are all (including Miss Goodchild) learning a new skill together-touch typing. It is to help the children understand that we ALL have things we find difficult and that new skills can take a lot of time and effort. We are focussing on our mindset hero who doesn't say, 'I'll never do it! It's too hard!'. He says, 'This may take some time and effort.'

In English we are focussing on our Reading Stamina! We are using Philip Pullman's- 'The Firework Maker's Daughter'. In maths Y3/4 have been working hard on our reasoning skills and choosing methods and Y2 have been working hard on additions that bridge multiples of 10.

Class 3

Class 3 have returned to school after the break full of beans. In our English, we are looking at what makes a good non-chronological report as well as understanding the use of relative clauses and semi colons. This week we have begun to research the Great Barrier Reef as part of our Australia topic. We will be writing reports on these next week.

In maths we are multiplying and dividing using known number facts as well as formal methods. We are then demonstrating our understanding of these operations in reasoning and problem solving tasks.

This week we have also been conducting experiments in our Science. Over this half term we will be investigating changing materials with reversible and non-reversible changes.
