This week Class 1 have continued work on capacity, focusing on non-standard units of measure. We have also organised information by displaying it in pictograms. Our literacy has included labelling drawings and using adjectives to describe dinosaurs. We have spent some time improving our listening and comprehension skills by trying to recall a piece of dinosaur information from a short text read to us. Trickier than we thought! We have been making the most of the beautiful sunshine, spending time outside playing, making dinosaur dens, leaving dinosaur trails and lots of other things prehistoric!

Class 2

Class 2 have been beavering away this week. In English we have applied our knowledge of the present perfect tense in our writing. Also, we have gathered lots of information all out life aboard an 18th century sailing ship, ready to write our diary entries next week. In Maths we have continued our investigation into fractions. We have looked at the links and patterns between equivalences and Y4s have started to use this knowledge and applied it to fractions.

Class 3

This week in class 3 our time travel journey moved to the Baroque period where we encountered the artist Bernini and the composer Vivaldi. As part of our cross curricular science and art we finished our Botanist watercolour illustrations and some of us attempted to sketch the Mona Lisa. In science our focus moved from flowering plants to non-flowering plants, looking at how they reproduce. In maths Y6 have focused on revision of key areas and Y5 have been learning about roman numerals. In English we had another of our whole school writes and this time we wrote super hero reports/descriptions.
