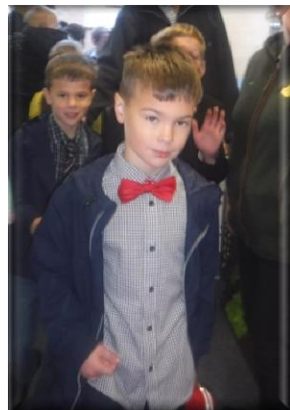


Book Fair

Class 1

This week we have been doing lots of fantastic learning in Class One. We have been continuing with our story of the Three Billy Goats Gruff and the children have been applying story language into their writing and developing their maths through investigations. We have talked about the different seasons and what signs we can see when it is Autumn. The children had lots of knowledge of seasons and the length of sunlight in each one! We have seen some super models this week including masks and skyscrapers!



Class 2

Class 2 have been busy writing their Egyptian adventure stories this week in English. In maths we have focussed on addition and subtraction and this will lead into us applying the skills we have learnt with money next week. We had a cross-curricular science and topic session Tuesday afternoon. The children looked at the mummification process as part of their topic work and we linked this to science by mummifying tomatoes in pairs- we will check them in 2 weeks' time to see how successful our mummification process was! We are still working hard at our growth mindset skills and in our reflection session this week we created 'Wanted' posters for fixed mindset villains who will try to battle against our growth mindset super heroes from our mindset board.

Class 3

Class 3 have once again been busy this week. In maths, we have been focusing on multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000 before coming onto mental addition and subtraction strategies at the end of the week. In our topic work, we have been researching Aztec Gods. In computing, the children have been investigating how pictures may not be as they seem, by altering original images.

This week in our spelling and grammar sessions, we shall be focusing on proofreading our own work. Next week, we shall be going to Easingwold School for a science day. Please make sure you get to school for 8.30 as the bus is leaving at 8.45 sharp.
