Class 1

This week in Class One the children have been working really hard on learning about how to sequence sentences and using clues in the text to help them decide how sentences join together to make sense. In Maths this week, the children have been practising some of the skills they have learnt this term and putting them into different contexts such as trying problem solving questions. The children have also been working really hard practising their play and they are extremely excited to be able to show you their performance. **We look forward to seeing everyone on Tuesday!**

Class 2



Class 2 have been comparing Christmas in Australia to Christmas in the UK this week and linked with the letter writing unit we have begun in English they wrote a postcard entry as if they were having Christmas in Australia. English has us looking at letter writing and the children had a whole school write task that involved writing a letter to Father Christmas or taking on the identity of Father Christmas and writing to a younger child. We are going to continue with this theme into next week and use the feedback from our first letter to improve our skills and write an even better letter to somebody next week. In maths Y3/4 have been focused on shape and Y2 have been looking at measures: Length and position. Next week we will focus solely on time across all year groups.

Class 3

In Class 3 this week, the children have been interpreting and creating line graphs and pie charts. As part of this we have written stories based on line graphs and answered sum and difference questions. In English, the children wrote a letter from Father Christmas as part of a whole school write. These were full of imagination and intrigue as they tried to use many of the taught features they have learnt this year.

In Science, we investigated changes of state, measuring using thermometers to see what happened when we read a poem with chocolate in our hands. The results were surprising.

Well done to all the children who took part in the Sportshall Athletics today - full report to follow next week.
