Class 1

We have had a busy week in class 1! On Tuesday, we took part in a music workshop called STOMP! Jessa showed us how to make music using instruments that we can make ourselves from recycling! We attended our own workshop and then came together with the rest of the school at the end of the day to show what we had learned! It was a fantastic day and all the children had lots of fun. We have also been learning how to log on and off Purple Mash. We have been learning about Algorithms and Debugging! Most children were able to log on independently and then choose how to move an object from one place to another using a set of instructions. They were then able to decide how to edit those instructions when they went wrong. We learned all about the importance of keeping safe online for Safer Internet Day and made posters about the things we like at school. We are then going to share these online through Class Dojo!

Class 2

Class 2 are always eager learners but on Tuesday the children had a particularly fun day. We began the day with science, Y2 focussed on mastering water resistance materials whilst Y3/4 put their evaporation and condensation knowledge to good use learning about the water cycle. We sang a song to help (she'll be coming round the mountain tune)
