## **Class 1**

Welcome back for the final part of the school year and what an exciting week we have had this week! We started the week with Mrs Withington and concluded it with Mr Barwick! We also welcomed two new friends to Class 1 - Izzy and Archie. They have settled in brilliantly! We think both are amazing and hope they will be very happy at Hushwaite.

Mrs Withington focused on reinforcing our time work – to the half hour – as well as days and months. We also looked closely at the poem, 'Where the Forest Meets the Sea' trying to work out what messages the poet was giving us through descriptive verses. Mr Barwick has helped us with numbers. We have worked out what numbers were missing, written words that correspond with the numbers, and thought carefully about the structure of different numbers, including partitioning. We also thought about how we can be kind and caring friends and what we can do to ensure we are the best we can be. Next Wednesday is our class trip (fingers crossed for some nice weather!). ## **Class 2**

Class 2 have once again worked their socks off this week. In maths, Year 2 have investigated patterns, Year 3 have been investigating shape and Year 4 have described and plotted the translation of shapes.

In English the children have identified the features of information texts before using this knowledge across the curriculum. We have started our new topic. 'France'. Over the coming weeks we shall be finding out more about the culture, geography and language.

Next week Year 3 and 4 will be undertaking some assessments.

## **Class 3**

Class 3 have come back bright and cheerful been focusing on their science this week, looking at how living things are classified and their writing this week has been based around this, with learning on biographies in particular. Maths has had us multiplying and dividing and the Y6s have also been doing some more open-ended investigations. We also began our topic work which will focus on Spain. Wednesday was the exciting day this week, we all went up to church and learnt about Pentecost, Reverend Liz and various church volunteers did a fabulous job of organising lots of different activities-even the teacher learnt a lot!
