This afternoon there is a special Remembrance Day collective worship in school; all the children have contributed to this and know why we have Remembrance Day. The Village Hall, Parish Council and St Nicholas' Church warmly invite everyone to their planned events this Sunday in the village. There is a Remembrance service at 10am, followed by a short commemoration and 2 minutes silence in front of the village war memorial. At 7pm a beacon will be lit on Beacon Banks, followed by fireworks and then a version of "land girls & boys" in the village hall.

Next week is National Anti-Bullying week and the children will be having a special assembly on Tuesday with Mr Chapman to mark this. The theme is 'Choose Respect' and the children are invited to wear odd socks on Monday, an opportunity for the children to express themselves, celebrate their individuality and what makes us all unique!
