Class 1

This week we started our new topic – transport! We read 'Whatever Next' and talked about our own journeys. We have been focussing on counting to 20, both forwards and backwards, and learning number bonds to 10 – *instantly!*

Class 2

This week Class 2 has continued their place value learning and we also began our practical maths sessions. In English we all had a go at writing non-chronological reports and began our phonic and spelling sessions. Science was exciting this week: Y2 had a visit from baby Scarlet and her mum and got to ask lots of questions, Y3/4 took part in an experiment to show how the digestive system works-I'm sure you will have heard about it! Children also started on their Egyptian death masks this week with Miss Wilkie which was another cause for great excitement.



Class 3

Class 3 have really got into the swing of things now and we are going full steam ahead. In maths we have been developing our knowledge and understanding of place value, writing numbers up to ten million and begun to use rounding.

In English we have written descriptions about our class text. We have also been learning about using dialogue to move on the action within narrative pieces.

Class 3 have researched and built Aztec Temples during outdoor learning. In our topic work, We researched significant events and milestones from the Aztec Empire and recorded these chronologically.

Well done to Year 6, who all successfully completed their bikeability course.
