Class 1

This week Class One looked at the changes in our seasons at the moment. We looked at the leaves and seeds at this time of year and made leaf pictures. We continued with our transport and journeys topic and started looking at how we could design a vehicle that we could then make with our junk modelling. Next week we will be aiming to design and make a model and learn more about transport through time!

Class 2

Class 2 are now well settled into their routines and I am especially impressed with the transition of the Y2 children; I am sure they are very tired by the end of the week but they are doing a fabulous job. I wasn't there for the first swim but Mrs Bainbridge was amazed at how well all the children did which is always lovely to hear as a class teacher 😊.

This week in maths we have been adding and subtracting in Y3/4 and Y2 have been looking at number pairs and balancing calculations. It's important that children understand mathematical symbols such as = have different vocabulary and meanings linked to them. In English we have been using the text a 'Huge Bag of Worries' and we will continue on this fiction text for the next couple of weeks building towards our own story. In topic the children enjoyed using the 'hot seat' to put themselves in Howard Carter and Tutankhamen's shoes especially using the Tutankhamen mask! The children have really enjoyed having an outdoor learning session each week and are throwing themselves into the jobs that need doing before autumn is over.

School council elections are being held today so we will soon know who will be helping Miss Goodchild improve the school! Their first meeting will be Monday and one of the first things on the agenda will be the book fair so look out for information coming soon...

Class 3

Class 3 have had another busy week. In English, we have acted out the thoughts of our characters in the story we are reading, before planning and writing a first draft of our own story. In maths, at the beginning of the week, we were investigating rounding. We then looked at negative numbers both in context and counting forwards and backwards with positive and negative numbers crossing zero.

Also this week, we have planned and investigated the strength of paper; looked at rites and rituals with Christian prayer; and we have also research the used of different Aztec artefacts.
