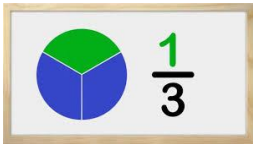

Class 1

This week the children have been learning how to count in multiples of two. We have been solving pair problems and were also sent a very special book all the way from Australia. We have been working on using adjectives to make our writing more exciting. We have also started practising for our nativity. It is very exciting play with lots of songs to learn. The children are doing really well to learn all the songs! We have also been investigating lots of other things including trains, boats and the weather. We were especially interested in the icy water tray where lots of objects had been frozen!



Class 2



Class 2 have been focussing on fractions this week, Y2 have looked at it linked with shape and Y3/4 have been looking at the connection between timetables multiplication and division facts and fractions. In English we have been practising our grammar knowledge, making sure we know what verbs, nouns, conjunctions and other terms mean as well as looking at how to create an image in poetry. Children did some extra art this week preparing their calendars with some aboriginal dot pictures as well as continuing their sewing projects in DT.

Class 3

This week in Class 3, the children have been learning about prime numbers, factors and multiples in maths. We have tackled problems showing excellent perseverance and growth mindset. In English, the children have learnt about direct and reported speech, interviewing those who emigrated to Australia (in role play) as part of the gold rush before reporting what they said. With the start of the Ashes in Australia this week, the children have investigated and compared UK and Australian sport, looking into the human geography of the country. Further to this we have learnt how to use MS Excel to make graphs about the climate in Australia.
