Class 2 are very much into their topic of Ancient Egyptians; this week we looked at hieroglyphs and the children really enjoyed writing messages for me to decipher. In English we are also now moving into writing some descriptive fiction based on a short animation called Tadeo Jones and his adventure in an Egyptian tomb.
