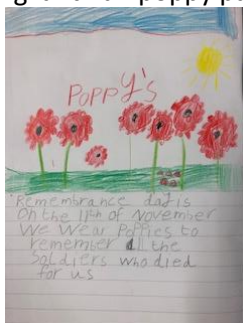

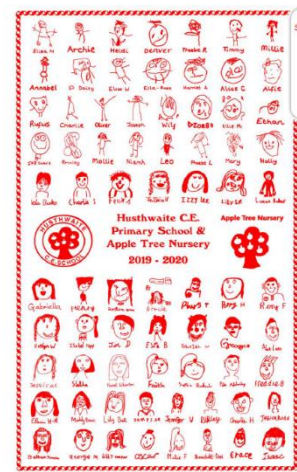
Thank you to our School Council for selling Poppies and stationary items etc in school to raise money for The Royal British Legion.
