Unfortunately, due to bubbles and current guidance we will be unable to have our normal July transition days in school where the children spend time in their new classes. To support transition for those children moving into a new class/having a new teacher, teachers will send out new class PowerPoints to give parents any new information they may need to support their child. Class Zooms on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July will be done in September 2020 Class groups to support transition for all children.

Otherwise, it's up to the children...
- PHASE 2 Part Time Return to School for all year groups.
  - Please remember to ensure your child is to school on time. Siblings can be dropped off together at your children's earliest time.

- Due to part time home/school learning, please can we all ensure we stick to the weekly timetables sent out weekly on Friday's for your child's class/year group to ensure continuity in learning. All the teachers have enjoyed seeing the children's Home Learning books, which they are trying to return quickly as they are obviously still needed at home.
- Please follow the attendance and illness guidelines in our Return to School Guide stringently to ensure everyone's continued safety. Inevitably, normal illness will occur, please continue to keep us informed and remember all children displaying any symptoms are entitled to a free COVID-19 test if ever you are unsure or worried.
- Please remember NYCC school transport needs to be booked weekly and the deadline is 12 o'clock on Monday's.
