Maths -Year will be focusing on area and perimeter in the measurement unit followed by multiplication and division. Year 5 will finish their unit on multiplication and division before acquiring new knowledge on fractions. Year 6 will be fraction-focused too. A reminder that an end of Year 4 objective is to know all times table to 12x12. If you know your child has gaps, please continue to practise at home.







English – Y5/6 will be using Who Let the Gods out in their reading practice sessions. Years 3 and 4 will be using Horrible Histories, Ruthless Romans. For writing we will draw on a range of texts for inspiration including some of the books pictured above.

We will be writing fiction, non-fiction linking our grammar to this, such as using expanded noun phrases, paragraphing, modal verbs and using different punctuation such as bullet points.



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
