Happy New Year

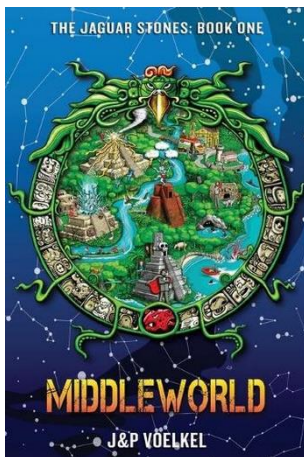
I hope everyone has had a lovely festive period.

A few reminders to start off with:

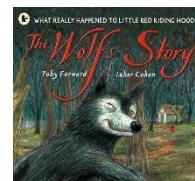
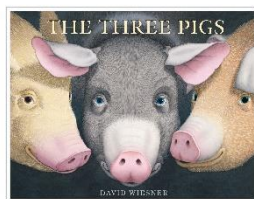
- Class 3 drop off is 8.40 and children are expected to be ready in the classroom by 8.50a.m. registration.

Our learning

Maths – Year 6 will begin with learning about ratio before delving into algebra. Year 4 and 5 will further their learning on multiplication and division Year 4 will then learn about length and perimeter; Year 5 will study fractions. A reminder that an **end of Year 4** objective is to know all times table to 12x12. If you know your child has gaps, please continue to practise at home.



English – Y5/6 will be using Middleworld in their reading practice sessions. Years 3 and 4 will be using a range of texts linked to the Three Little Pigs, including alternative versions.



The main grammar foci for Y3 and 4 will be punctuating speech and the perfect form (tense); for Years 5 and 6, relative clauses and cohesive devices.
