Home-School Books

These books should be in school daily, this helps us send messages home and also record reading. It's also essential for children being able to access their passwords for online learning. This is where we stick them so children always have access and can work independently. I will not see everyone's book on a daily basis, if there is a note for me then your child must be aware that they need to bring it to my attention or I may miss it. If the message is urgent please telephone the office, if it only needs answering by the end of the day/within a couple of days you can also use Class Dojo.

Homework: will begin next week. There will be a note in their CGP homework book to explain.

- Spellings will be set at the beginning of each half term. These will be done using Dojo. (Parents can access them from there) and tested Fridays.
- Times tables: I will put a note on Dojo explaining which tables each year group will be tested on weekly for this half term. Times tables will be tested Thursday mornings.

Reading

Y2 reading will continue as they did in Y1 till they complete the Big Cat Reading Scheme then they will move onto the next reading programme and we will change how they bring books home which will be explained at the time. Can I make a big plea that when you hear your child read at home that it's recorded in the home school book. There are also sections at the front and back for children to record books they are reading at home. Y2 will bring home reading books Thursday/Friday as they did in Y1.

Mondays and Thursdays will be the days I send Y3 children to the library to change their home reading books. For Y3 we will tick off how often children change their reading books so we can continue to monitor how often children are reading and any children who are not reading regularly.
